Installation Guide

- 1. Please connect IPMI module to the ASMB BMC2 connector using the following steps.
 - Connect BMC2 with the screw holes on your ASMB. If your ASMB is ASMB-587, you will find two screw holes around BMC2.

2). Connect BMC_CN1 with screw holes on IPMI-2000.
